# HME 6000 ODYSSEY PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

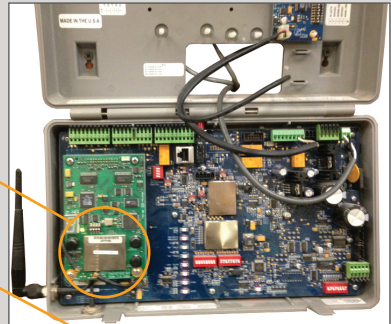
for HME 6000 BASE STATION



Following are the programming instructions for your HME 6000 headset and HME 6000 base station.

- 1 Place battery in belt pack or all-in-one headset, do not turn the unit on during this step.  
**FOR BELT PACKS:**  
Make sure to plug a working headset into unit.
- 2 Open Base Station on the wall by depressing clips at the top.
- 3 Once open, locate the LED display to the left as well as three black buttons.
- 4 Press the black “start registration” button in the lower right hand corner.
- 5 You should see a “0” (half zero, just the bottom of the LED “8” will be lit) appear on the LED display.
- 6 Turn on belt pack / all-in-one headset while pressing “B” button, then release both buttons at the same time. You will hear registration mode communications thru the headset.
- 7 It will take only a few seconds and the red light on unit should turn green.
- 8 **If an “F” flashes on your base station, call 800-598-2370.**  
“F” indicates that maximum units have been registered. History needs to be cleared.

## HME 6000 ODYSSEY PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

for HME 6000 ION BASE STATION



Following are the programming instructions for your HME 6000 headset and HME ION base station.

- 1 Make sure the headset has a fully charged battery installed and the power is **OFF**.
- 2 Hit any button on the **BASE STATION** to light up the screen.
- 3 Select the **MENU** option (bottom left, black arrow).
- 4 Then select **REGISTER HEADSETS** option (top right, black arrow).
- 5 Then select **REGISTER HEADSETS** option (bottom right, black arrow).
- 6 Select **REGISTER SINGLE** (bottom left) or **REGISTER MULTIPLE** (bottom right, only if you have multiple headsets to register).
- 7 On your headset, hold down the “**B-BUTTON**” and the **RED POWER BUTTON** together.
- 8 Once you see the **RED** and **GREEN** lights on the on the headset, you are in registration mode and can release the buttons.
- 9 When the light on the headset turns green, that means it’s registered. This may take up to a minute. The base station will revert to the home screen automatically.
